- ❖ Removed 2 Incumbents for endorsing Animal Rights Reps on the Fish & Game Council.
- ❖ Created NJOA Conservation Foundation: a council of 28 Outdoor Minded Organizations.
- ❖ Created the NJOA Environmental Projects: a charity to enhance outdoor experiences.
- ❖ Developed 'Outdoors Action Alert' to 'call to action' when our Rights are threatened.
- ❖ Employed one of the most prestigious lobbying firms in Trenton.
- ❖ Creation & implementation of the Anglers and Hunters Conservation Caucus in Trenton.
- ❖ Sat on Governor's Transition Team to assure Sportsmen's issues were heard.
- ❖ Restored and funded the Hooked On Fishing Not on Drugs Program by the Legislature
- ❖ Worked with DEP to reject the ASMFC's ludicrous summer flounder regulations

Local Battles Won by NJOA

Protecting the Rights of Outdoor Sportsmen and Sportswomen:

- ❖ Defeated an anti-duck hunting agenda that was wrongfully influencing town officials on the Shrewsbury and Navesink Rivers
- ❖ Endorsement of a continued Monmouth County Parks Regulated Deer Management Hunt that was threatened by animal right extremists.
- ❖ Helped create an amended MVP (Motorized Vehicle Plan) in getting access restored to Wharton State Forest
- ❖ Stood along N.Y. Bay Keeper in preserving Liberty State Park from Development that would have limited outdoor opportunities
- ❖ Testified at Wall Township and Colts Neck meetings against the threat of anti-hunting ordinances.
